MOUNT KENYA CLIMBING

Mt Kenya is the highest Mountain in Kenya, and the second-highest in Africa (after Mount Kilimanjaro), The main summits are the twins Batian and Nelion, which can only be reached by means of technical climbing, and the third highest summit, Point Lenana, (4985m) - is glaciated but accessible to walkers, making the walk around point Lenana the most beautiful expedition in the East African mountains
